- **Dealing with the criminal justice system**  
What can you do to help the police and the courts to understand the symptoms of TS?  
How could you respond to the threat of prosecution for TS-related behaviour?
- **Employment Tribunals**  
What can tribunals do? What can't they do?  
What can you expect when you get there?
- **Your rights as a consumer**  
What rights do you have in shops, restaurants and on public transport, for example?
